Year-round, girls and boys learn oceanography, marine science, environmental science, boating safety, dinghy and keelboat sailing, rowing, canoeing, kayaking, motor boating, and other aquatic-related subjects.

A shining example of what a privately-funded and publicly-accessible facility can do, the Newport Sea Base counts an overall attendance of more than 53,000 per year.

NO EXPERIENCE NECESSARY! Bring a good attitude and a willingness to work hard. The goals of our Middle School program are to introduce the sport of rowing, have fun on and off the water, provide a safe environment, and learn basic technical skills and proper boat handling while developing fitness.

JOURNEY TO THE OCEAN

ACTIVITIES FOR KIDS

AQUA CUB | 2 HOURS

Kids learn boating safety and water rescues -- and get to row a boat within our dock area. Great photo op!

Ages: 5 - 10 | **Fee:** \$10

RAIN GUTTER REGATTA | 2 HOURS

Kids design their own sails, then race their mini catamarans!

Ages: 5 - 11 | **Fee:** \$15

INTRO TO SAILING | 4 HOURS

Kids practice rigging a small sailboat and learn the basics of using the wind to propel them down the bay.

Ages: 7 - 10 | **Fee:** \$100

HUCK FINN FISHING | 2 HOURS

A stick, some line, a hook and bait - Kids cruise to fishing hot spots and try their luck from our boat and dock.

PADDLE SPORT ADVENTURE & BBQ | 2 HOURS

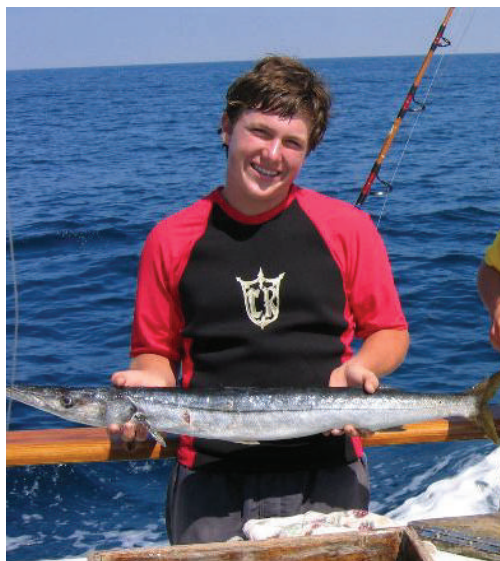
Hop onto a kayak, canoe or stand up paddle board and seek to fulfill your mission! Our grill, fridge and freezer are available for your event.

\$5 MILLION ENDOWMENT CAMPAIGN

HELP US RAISE \$5 MILLION BY 2025

Since its inception, the Newport Sea Base has served over 200,000 youth right here in Orange County. In order to keep this opportunity open to as many youth as possible, prices are subsidized at below cost rates.

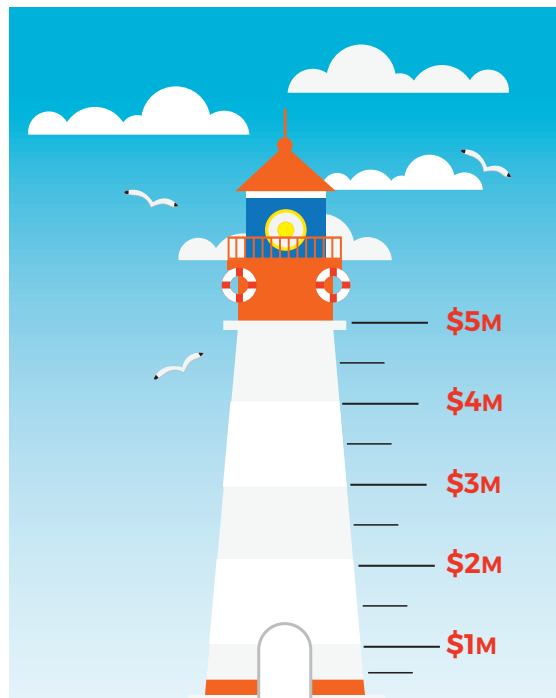
Program fees constitute roughly 50% of the annual operating budget and the shortfall must be raised by other means. When presented with budget constraints, maintenance and capital needs are deferred which in a salt water environment results in ever-mounting dock and boat bottom cleaning and perpetual metal oxidizing costs.

It is time to endow the Newport Sea Base permanently so that thousands of youth in our community continue to have access to boating and maritime opportunities that otherwise would be out of reach.

Help keep this community marine education center thriving. Let's raise \$5 million by 2025!

Interest earned would:

- Double the maintenance budget to \$100,000 annually
- Increase the Journey to the Ocean program capacity to serve 2,500 students per year
- Help bring back a long-term Adventure Camp vessel (a 25-person overnight capacity vessel)
- Keep pace with California minimum wage increases for staffing costs
- Maintain a mission-focused program staff
- Award more scholarships for long-term programs such as Sea Scouts, Rowing, and Offshore Sailing
